

# 4-1-1. Trends in Applications (Undergraduate, General Admission)

There are between 3.3 and 3.8 applicants for every place in the process for general admission (general entrance examination) to undergraduate programs at Kyushu University.

The ratio of applicants to places was lowest for the FY2015 entrance examinations, at 3.35. The Public Nationwide, too, the number of applicants to national universities is on the decline.







No major changes can be seen, even on the public nationwide scale. While there is a downward trend in the number of places available at national universities, the number available at public universities is on the rise.




### 4-1-3. Trends in Applications (Undergraduate, General Admission / by Undergraduate School)

The ratio of applicants to places ranges between 2.4 and 2.8 in the first selection, and between 8.3 and 9.9 in the second selection, so the university is able to secure a stable supply of entrants.

# 4-2-1. Trends in Applications (Graduate School — Master's Program)


