

# 4-1. Undergraduate Admissions

# 4-1-1. Trends in Undergraduate Admissions: General Admission

There are between 3.3 and 3.8 applicants for every place in the process for general admission (general entrance examination) to undergraduate programs at Kyushu University. The ratio of applicants to places was lowest for the FY2015 entrance examinations, at 3.35. The nationwide, as well, the ratio of applicants to places of national universities is on the decline.




# 4-1-2. Trends in Undergraduate Admissions: General Admission (by Admission Schedule)

The ratio of applicants to places ranges between 2.4 and 2.8 in the first selection, and between 8.3 and 9.9 in the second selection, so the university is able to secure a stable supply of entrants. The number of places available at national universities is on a downward trend.






# 4-1-3. Trends in Undergraduate Admissions (by School)

The ratio of applicants to places ranges between 1.8 to 3.9 in the first selection, and between 5.8 and 20.0 in the second selection. And for the admissions office entrance examination, it ranges between 0.8 and 10.4. Examinations for specially recommended applicants are provided for the School of Interdisciplinary Science and Innovation only.

While the situation differs from one graduate school to another, all schools are managing to secure international applicants.





The number of Law School applicants rose slightly over the preceding year. The number of applicants to the Professional Graduate School of Public Health, however, dropped notably.




# 4-2-3. Trends in Graduate Admissions: Doctoral Programs
