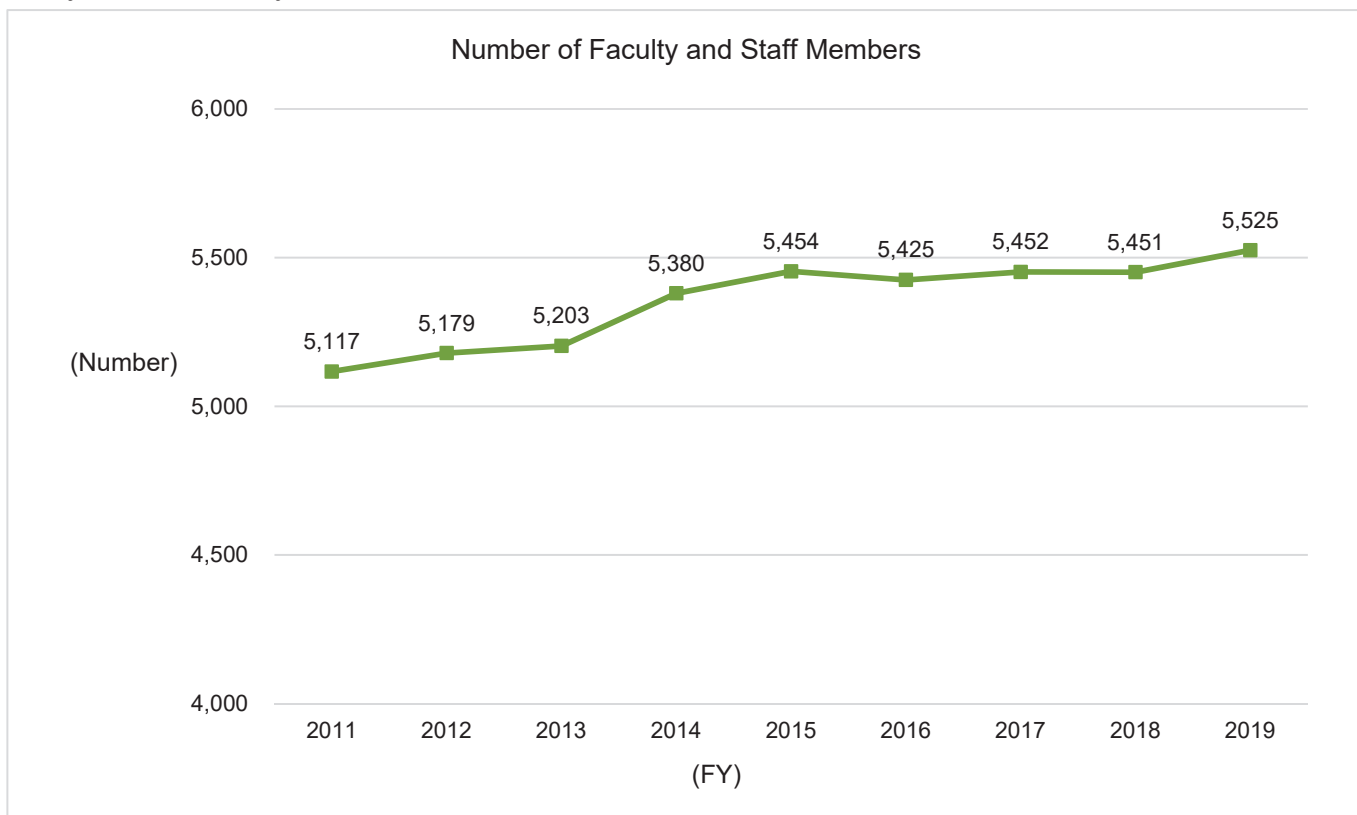

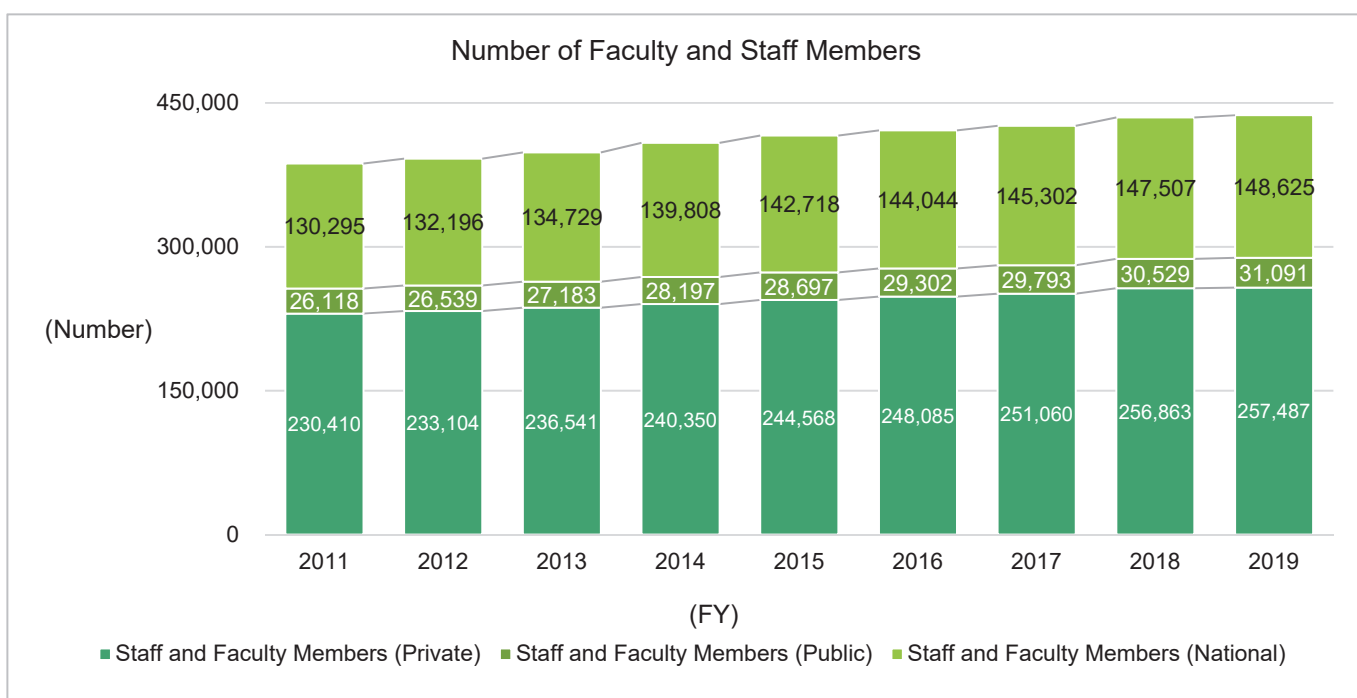

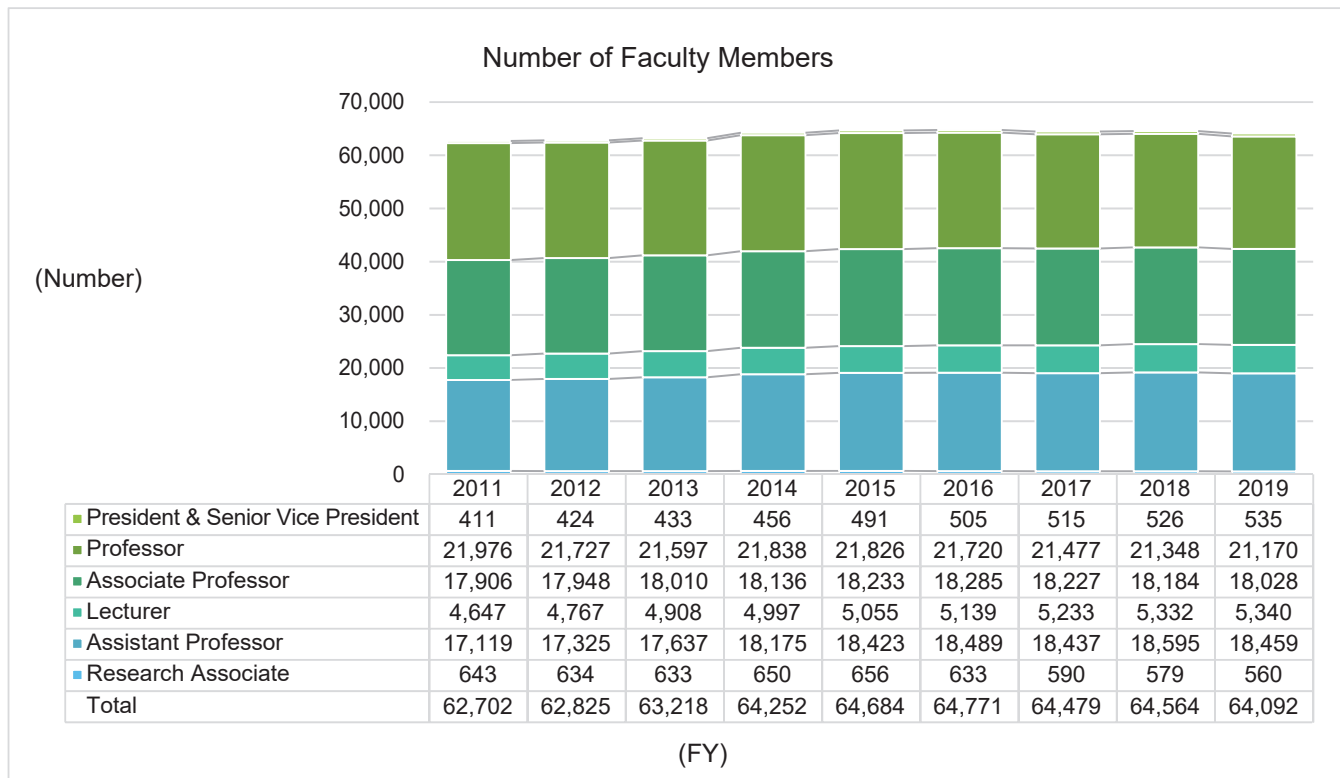

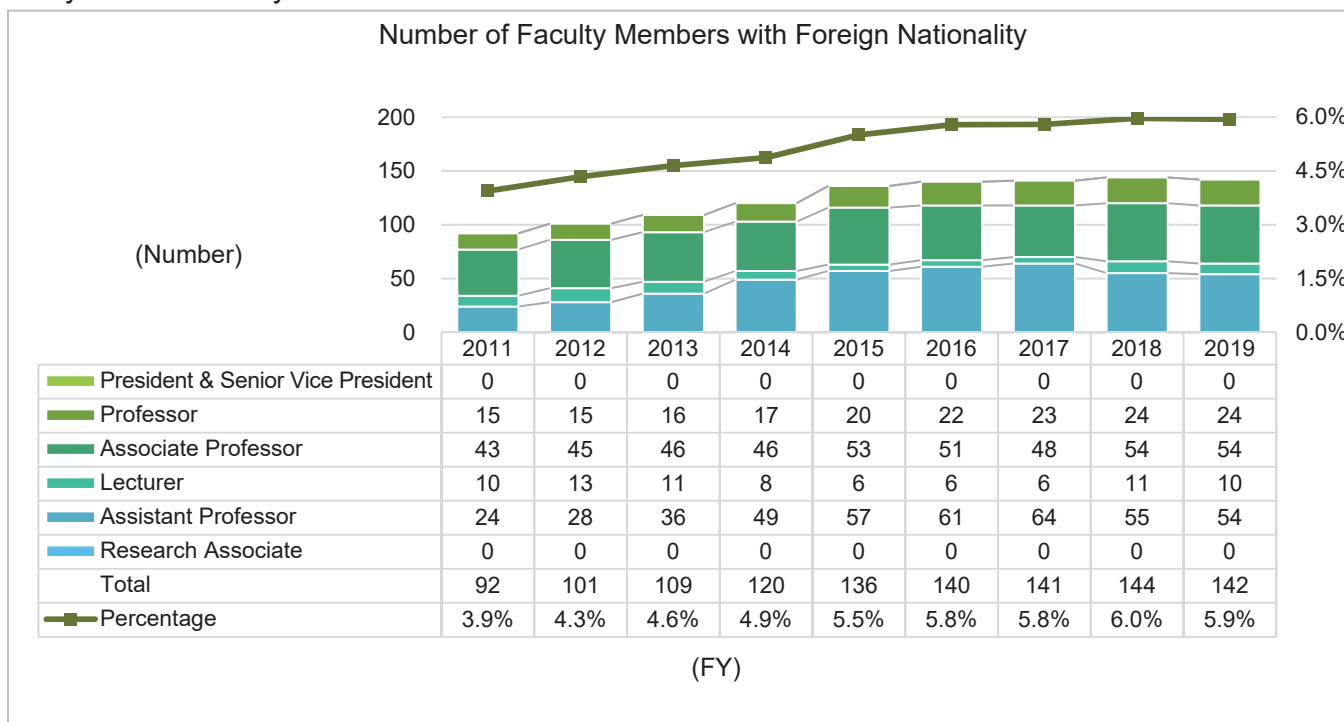

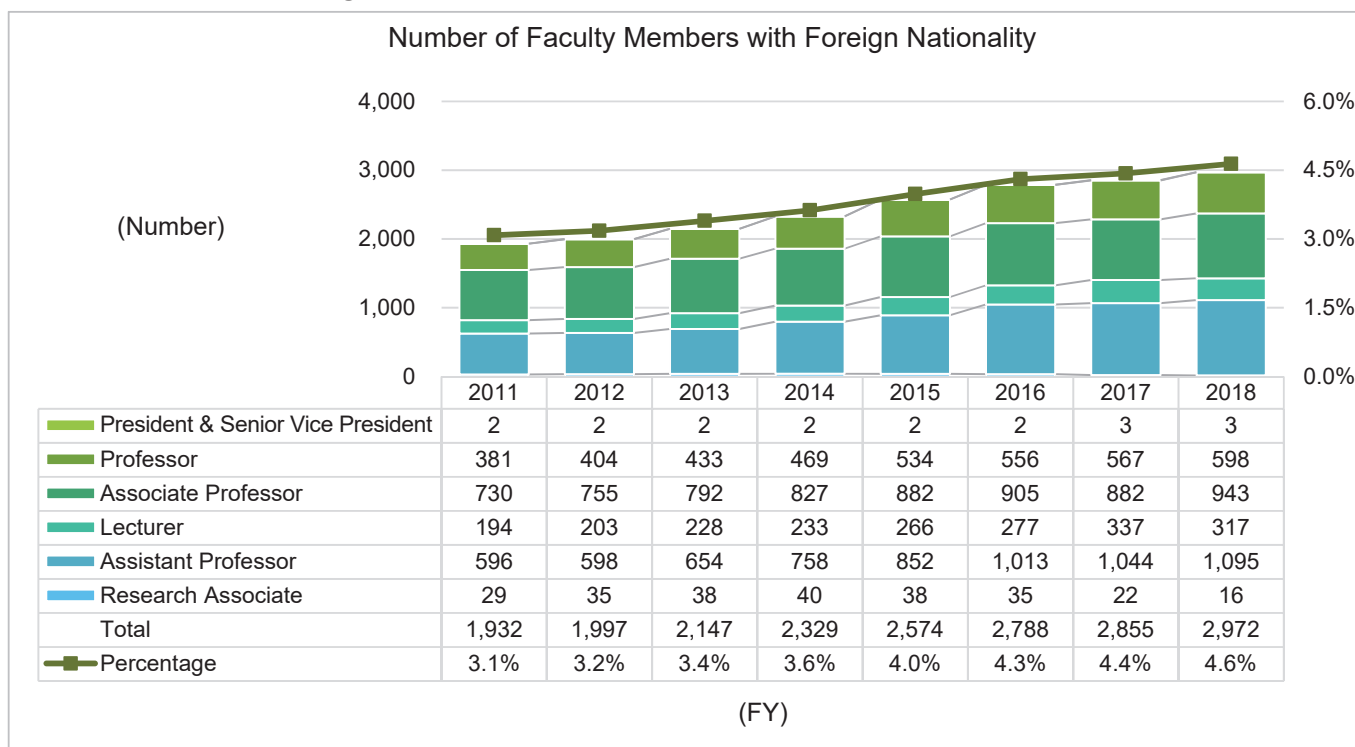

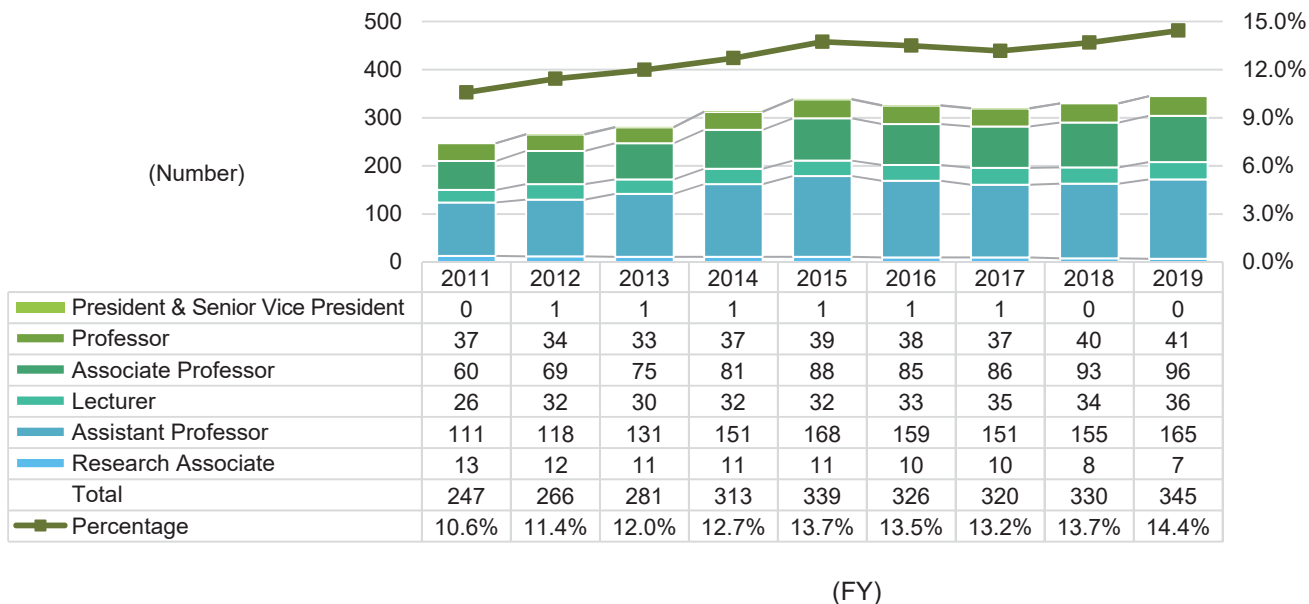

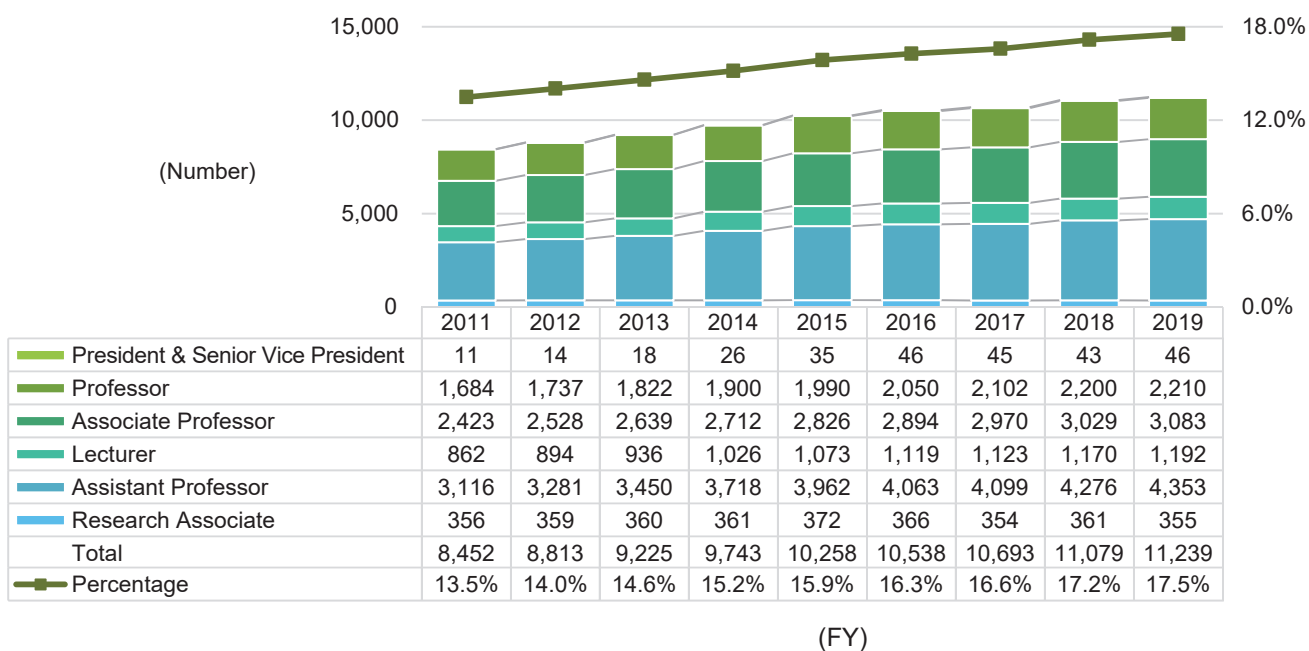
Number and Percentage of Women Faculty Members

Number and Percentage of Women Faculty Members

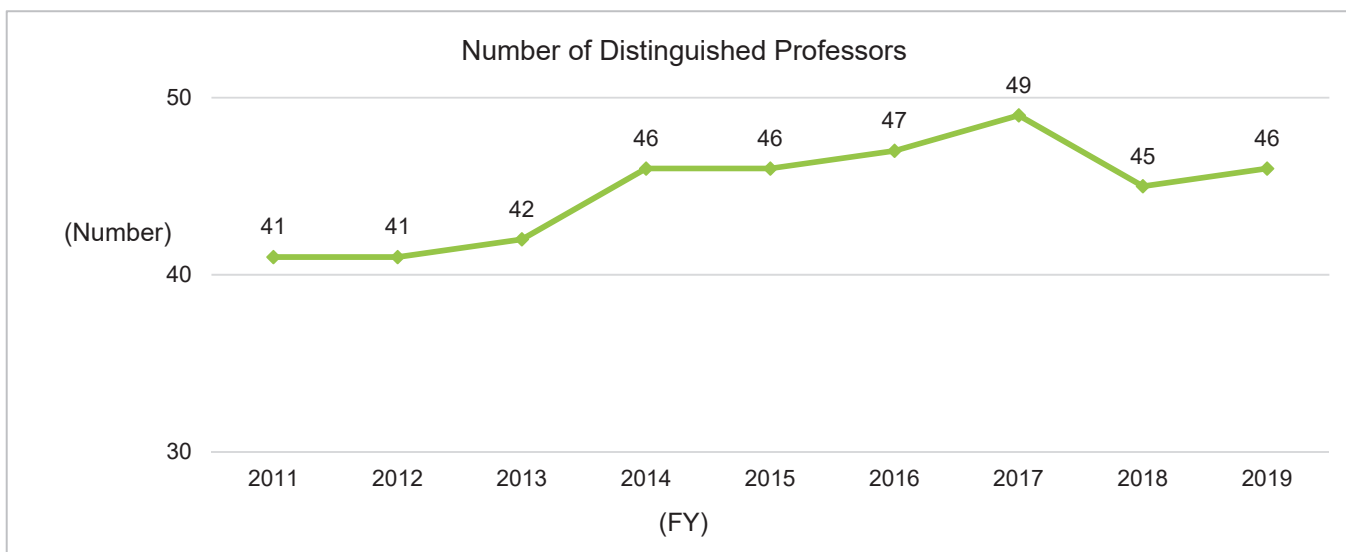

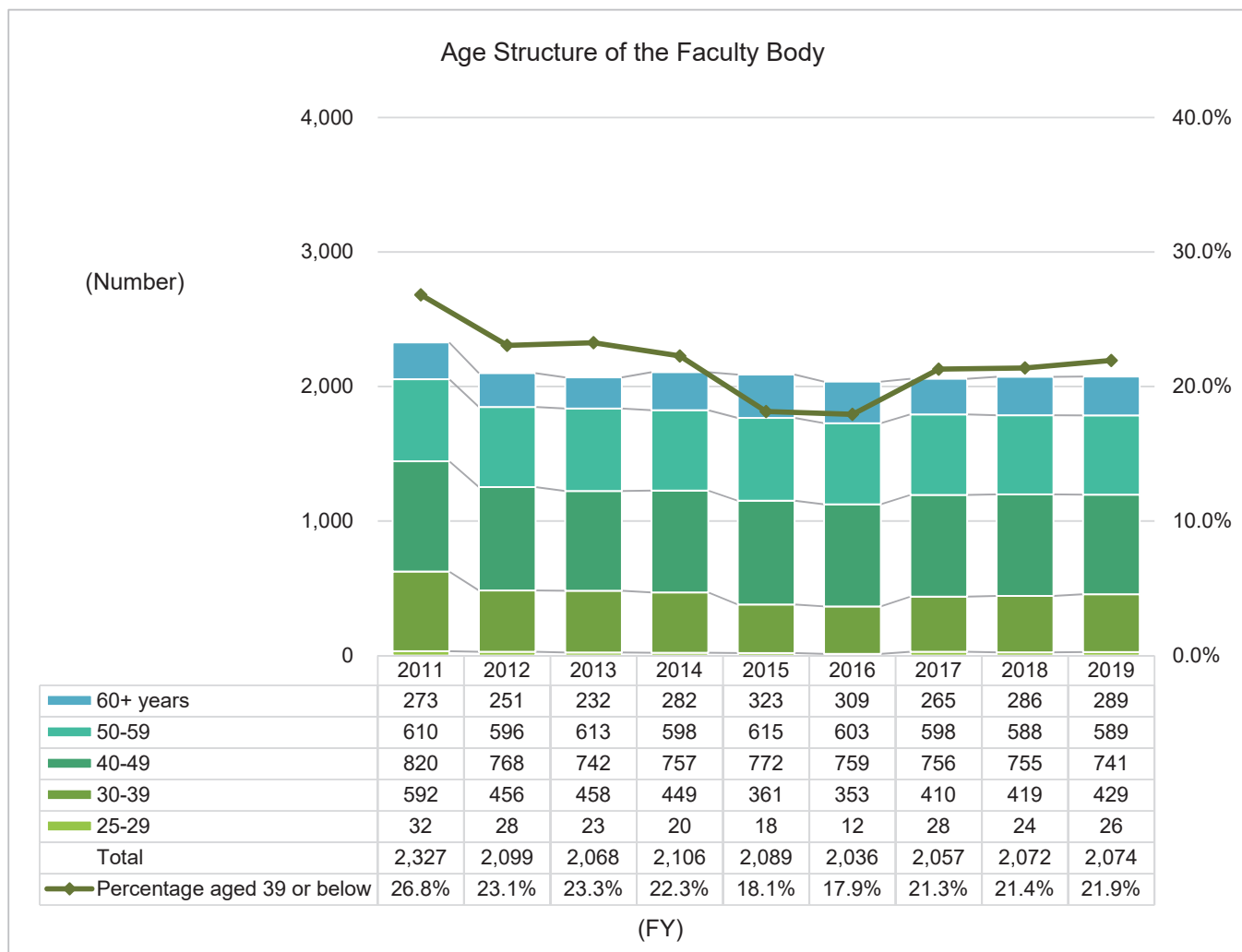

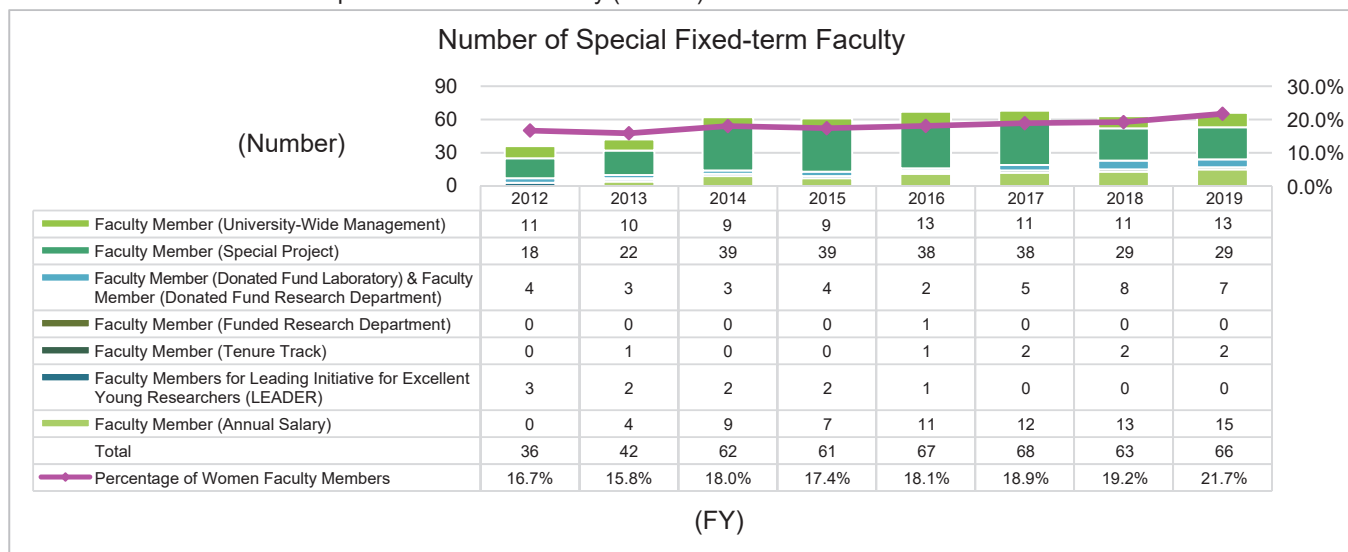
