


KPI: Number of international faculty and faculty with international experience

KPI: Articles published with international coauthors over a 5-year period




• The polygonal line indicates the total number of international co-authored publications in the last five years, including the relevant year.

KPI: Articles published in top ten percent journals over a 5-year period




• The polygonal line indicates the total number of publications in top 10% of journals in the last five years, including the relevant year.

KPI: Percentage of young researchers






